



## Rules of Young Scientist Awards at ICCPB 2015 conference in Kraków

1. The Young Scientist Awards are offered to young researchers:
  - post-docs (up to 5 years after PhD, excluding periods of parental leave)
  - students (any education level before obtaining PhD), who are the presenting authors of outstanding oral presentations.
2. Prizes of in the amount of 300 to 500 Euros (or equivalent in a different currency) will be awarded to the best oral presentations from all symposia.
3. The prizes are funded by various sponsors. The name of the sponsor will be added to the name of a particular award and will be announced during the Closing Ceremony and posted on the conference website, together with the name of the laureate.
4. Abstracts of the presentations must be submitted by the authors according to general rules (deadline: 15th June) and pre-registered in the competition:
  - in step 5 of the abstract submission system (Options) enter in the 'Comments' field a note: 'CONSIDER FOR YOUNG SCIENTIST AWARD';
  - send to [iccpb2015@uj.edu.pl](mailto:iccpb2015@uj.edu.pl) an e-mail with the abstract author and title, and a short note with request for considering the abstract for YOUNG SCIENTIST AWARD' competition, and declaration of eligibility (year of obtaining PhD or a declaration of student's status).
5. An evaluation of presentations will be two-stage. In the first stage, symposia organizers will choose one presentation per symposium from presentations submitted for the award. In the second stage, a committee which will consist of representatives of award sponsors and congress organizers will evaluate oral presentations during regular symposia sessions to choose the winners.
6. The Awards will be announced and handed during the Closing Ceremony on 28th August.
